



OBJECTIVE: For North American stations to contact as many radio amateurs as possible. For non-North American stations to contact as many North American stations as possible.

BANDS: 80, 40 and 20 meters only. Suggested frequencies are around 3770-3790 and 3805-3825 (avoid DX window), 7225 and 14,275 kHz

CONTEST PERIODS: SSB: 0000 through 0359 UTC, March 16, 2014

LOG SUBMISSION: Entries must be received no later than 7 days after the Sprint. To submit your Cabrillo log, visit ncjweb.com/ sprintlogsubmit




